## Summer Camp Q&A

Q; What are the dates and times of camp?

A; June 26th-September 1st, 9am-3pm, we will not have camp on July 4th

Q: What grades is camp?

A: Kindergarten - 8th grade. Kids are typically grouped K-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8. Based on volume groups will be combined or separated. You register for the grade you are entering into in the fall of 2023

Q; How much is camp?

A; If you register before May 1st camp is \$275 per week, \$195 for 3 days a week or \$75 per day. After May 1st camp is \$300 per week, \$225 for 3 days a week, or \$80 per day.

Q; Do you offer any discounts?

A; YES. we offer a 10% sibling discount and if you register for 4 or more weeks you save another 10%

Q; Do you offer before and after care?

A; YES. Before care 7am-9am \$10 per hour or \$15 for both. After care 3pm-5pm \$10 per hour or \$15 for both

Q; Do you offer hot lunch?

A; YES. \$7 per day \$30 per week, you can find the menu online. If you would like to add an additional slice of pizza to a child's lunch each day that would be an extra \$3 or they can substitute any meal for pizza everyday.

Q; What is the CIT Program

A; Counselors in training. This is offered to campers who have aged out of summer camp but are still too young to work. This program is offered to 9th and 10th grade students.(see CIT page on website for full break down of the program)

Q: What are the ratios of campers to counselors?

A: For the younger group (K-2) the ratio is 1 counselor to every 7 children. For the rest of camp we have a 1 counselor to every 10 children ratio.
